On Wednesday, March 18, Laramie County School District 1's youth feeding program will provide double meal service. Due to the severe weather forecast, the program will not run Thursday, March 19. The service is expected to resume Friday, March 20 and will also be available March 23-27. Community members are strongly encouraged to take advantage of the double service on Wednesday.

People may pick up the breakfast/lunch combination bags from 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m., at the following locations, which are sites approved by the Wyoming Department of Education.

1. Afflerbach – parent pick up lane on the south side of the school
2. Alta Vista – northeast parking lot at 17th and Logan
3. Arp – parent pick up lane on the west side of the school
4. Baggs – bus lane on the west side of the school
5. Cole – south of the school in corner of O'Neil and 8th
6. Fairview – north of school on 10th St.
7. Goins – parent pick up lane east of school
8. Hebard – east of school on Pebrican Ave.
9. Henderson – northeast side of school on Kelley Dr.
10. Lebhart – north of school on Hanson St.
11. Rossman – parent pick up lane on the east side of the school
12. Sunrise – parent pick up lane on the west side of the school
13. Johnson – bus lane on the southwest side of the school
14. South – east parking lot

Any youth, 18 years of age or younger, are eligible for food bags at any location. Pick up is being done using a walk-up or drive-through process. Students need not be present for parents/guardians to pick up the bags.
