### **Laramie County School District 1 expands youth feeding program**

Beginning Monday, April 13, the USDA has granted Laramie County School District 1 approval to expand its youth feeding program to serve areas outside of neighborhoods that receive Federal Title I funding.

The program, which provides breakfast/lunch combination bags, will continue through the duration of the district's COVID-19 closure. People may pick up food bags Monday-Friday at a variety of sites, which have been approved by the Wyoming Department of Education.

Food bag pick up will be held from 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. at the following locations.

1. Afflerbach – parent pick up lane on the south side of the school
2. Alta Vista – northeast parking lot at 17<sup>th</sup> Street and Logan Avenue
3. Arp – parent pick up lane on the west side of the school
4. Baggs – bus lane on the west side of the school
5. Cole – south of the school in corner of O'Neil Avenue and Eighth Avenue
6. Goins – parent pick up lane east of school
7. Hebard – east of school on Pebrican Avenue
8. Rossman – parent pick up lane on the east side of the school
9. Sunrise – parent pick up lane on the west side of the school
10. Anderson – end of the parent pickup lane on the south side of the school
11. McCormick – bus lane on the east side of the school on Education Drive
12. Pioneer Park – south of the school in the cul-de-sac at the end of Talbot Court

Food bag pick up will be held from 11:30 a.m.-noon at the following locations.

1. Henderson – northeast side of school on Kelley Drive
2. Fairview – north of school on 10<sup>th</sup> Street
3. Johnson – bus lane on the southwest side of the school

Food bag pick up will be held from 12:15 p.m.–12:45 p.m. at the following locations.

1. Dildine – parking lot
2. Lebhart – northeast of school on Hanson Street
3. South – east parking lot

Any youth, 18 years of age or younger, are eligible for food bags at any location. Pick up is being done using a walk-up or drive-through process. Students need not be present for parents/guardians to pick up the bags.
